2011 Action Plan Update (In order of strategy and activity)

Strategy 2A: Educational Updates

- The next FIPAC meeting has been postponed until further notice.
 - Meeting details will be provided by the Office of Injury Prevention (OIP) as soon as they are available.

Strategy 2F: By July 31, 2011, conduct a satellite broadcast for the injury prevention community on the topic of human trafficking.

- The broadcast will be held on January 6, 2011 from 9 am — noon.
- The OIP is working on being able to provide continuing medical education units (CMEs) and continuing education units (CEUs) for broadcast participants.
- Florida State University's Center for the Advancement of Human Rights has offered to host the recorded broadcast on their web site.

Office of Injury Prevention Update

- The OIP is currently working on the applications for the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Core I grant and extensions.
 - The 2005 Core I grant, which was awarded to the OIP, provided funding for the 2004-2008 and 2009-2013 Florida Injury Prevention Strategic Plan activities.
 - Funding from the 2003 grant will end on July 31, 2011.
 - The new funding includes five sections; a core grant and 4 extension grants — Regional Network Leader (RNL), Surveillance Quality Improvement (SQI), Senior Falls (Falls) and Motor Vehicle Traffic Policy (MVP).
 - The OIP will be submitting applications for the core grant as well for SQI and Falls. The OIP may be submitting an application for the RNL extension as well.
