



2009-2013 Florida Injury Prevention Strategic Plan Goal Team 3 Conference Call Minutes

November 8, 2011 10:00 am – 11:00 am EST

Welcome and Roll Call

- Sarah Hinkel-Young opened the meeting by welcoming everyone and calling roll. An attendee list is included below.

2011 Senior Falls Awareness Day

- Sarah Hinkel-Young reviewed the activities of 2011 Senior Falls Awareness Day.
 - Over 16 different agencies took part on the local level and had activities that ranged from balance and vision checks by local physical therapy students to medication checks by a local pharmacy. In addition, many education and awareness activities took place.
 - Sarah Hinkel-Young and Michele Mulé reported all local activities to the National Council on Aging. They were very impressed with Florida's participation and efforts.
 - At the state level, the Senior Falls Prevention Coalition (Coalition) in conjunction with Goal Team 3 put on the 2011 Senior Falls Awareness Day Webcast, which provided 50 nursing CEU's and two physician CME's. The webcast was viewed by several hundred people, located as far as Washington State.
 - The Coalition and Goal Team 3 successfully received a Governor's Proclamation for Senior Falls Awareness Day.

Review of FIPAC Meeting and Goal Team 3 Break-Out Session

- The Florida Injury Prevention Advisory Council (FIPAC) meeting was held in Ft. Lauderdale, FL on September 27-28, 2011. During the meeting, Goal Team 3 had a break-out session in which they reviewed the progress of the 2011 Action Plan. During the break-out session, several of the 2012 Action Plan items were amended due to the creation of the Florida Senior Falls Prevention Strategic Plan under the Coalition. Changes include the following:
 - Transfer of Strategy 3D to the Florida Senior Falls Prevention Strategic Plan.
 - Amend activity 3E(1) to read, "support the coalition..."
 - Amend activity 3E(2) to read, "Provide the coalition..."
 - Transfer activity 3E(3) to the Florida Senior Falls Prevention Strategic Plan.
 - Transfer activity 3E(4) to the Florida Senior Falls Prevention Strategic Plan.
 - Transfer activity 3G(2) to the Florida Senior Falls Prevention Strategic Plan.
 - Amend activity 3G(3) to read, "Recommend any new CDC evidence based interventions to the Coalition."
- The FIPAC meeting also discussed the development of two program interventions and two policy strategies per the requirements of the new CDC Core Violence and Injury Prevention Program Grant. The topics that were voted on by FIPAC are senior falls prevention and childhood drownings for program interventions, and senior falls preventions and motor vehicle crashes for policy strategies.
 - Goal Team 3 members discussed how the new focus for program interventions and policy strategies would affect the goal team. Sarah Hinkel-Young asked



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members that were interested to volunteer to be a part of the policy subcommittee for senior falls prevention. Members that volunteered included:

2011 and 2012 Action Plan Updates

- Sarah Hinkel-Young announced that all but two activities under the 2011 Action Plan had been completed. The two remaining activities were currently in process and would be completed prior to the end of 2011.
- 2012 Action Plan has been developed. A few strategies had been completed ahead of schedule. These included Strategy 3, which was to develop a pilot project of identified evidence-based interventions.
 - Goal team members decided that instead of developing a second evidence-based intervention, that 2012 would be spent supporting the current intervention, Tai Chi: Moving for Better Balance, to help develop long-term sustainability.

Florida Senior Falls Prevention Strategic Plan

- Sarah Hinkel-Young provided the goal team members with an update regarding the development of the Florida Senior Falls Prevention Strategic Plan. The plan was developed during the Coalitions meeting in Ft. Lauderdale, FL on the morning of September 27, 2011. It includes 6 goals, each with a goal team leader. Goal Team leaders are currently reviewing funding implications and timelines for the different strategies associated with their goals. The whole plan will be completely finalized at the next Coalition meeting on November 29, 2011. Yearly action plans will be developed from there.
