- Community Enhancement Area (CEA) Funds
  - o Approval for \$35,000, pending BCC approval in July
  - o Approved for Community Center Improvements, including lighting at the community center parking lot
  - o Approved for E-Learning section in community center, to
  - o Overall excitement for approval, but some residents feel money for community center should come from Public Works, as the poor parking lot lighting is perceived as a county safety/liability issue
- Action Plans
  - o Guest Speakers: Environmental Services speaking on the water system and County Commissioner attendance at association was cancelled at the last minute by speakers
  - o United Way of Lake/Sumter County is hosting a Public Assistance day June 10th in Community
  - Attendees include: DCF, Workforce CentralFL, Lake Elder Affairs, Good Will, Sherriff's Office (fingerprinting & Safety Info for Elders), Transportation, and IRS
  - o Transportation
  - Corridor study proposed in South Umatilla in County's Strategic Plan, value: \$150,000
  - New bus stop marker for LakeXpress at North end of community

o Street Lighting Petition

They want to get signatures for a petition for street lighting MSTUs, but no further movement forward

Some disagreement on if individuals or group should pay for lighting

o Litter/Abandoned Buildings

Public Works says cannot get No Littering sign for the undeveloped property along the community border, where garbage and junk is being dumped; go through Code Enforcement  
Community Clean ups still occurring quarterly for Adopt a Road
